While watching many groups on the major league baseball field before games, he thought, "Why not have the Royal Rangers doing the same thing?" After one meeting with a Braves' representative, Norm had found a way to join two passions together - the Royal Rangers and the Atlanta Braves - thus was created "Royal Rangers Night with the Atlanta Braves."
