Could it be, Thornton suggests, that problem-solving processes provide the fundamental machinery for cognitive development? In *Children Solving Problems* she synthesizes the dramatic insights and findings of post-Piagetian research and sets the agenda for the next stage in understanding the varied phenomena of children's problem-solving.
