Thanks to this diary written by a janissary clerk about 1711 Pruth Campaign, it is a probability that we have the opportunity to know better than the historian of the period. While setting off the final campaign as a janissary who served for 55 years, the Janissary Clerk Hasan embraced the paper and quill to create a witness for the history, not only as a part of his job. He recorded the campaign starting from the announcement of the war and to the thorough political evaluation of the period in an international scale: The campaign march, arrival at the battle zone, accommodation, battles, influx of serdengeçtis, desertion of soldiers, chasing off the enemy and signing a peace treaty... Having mentioned about those who had neglected and disregarded their duties and obligations and were sentenced after the war and about the diplomacy processes with Russia, the Janissary Clerk Hasan puts an end to his words by expressing that: "I would like those who has the knowledge and read this diary to remember me with blessings, and to complete the deficiencies in my words and correct and cover up my mistakes." The Janissary Clerk Hasan was born as a son of a father who had also served as a janissary and followed the path of his father. He became a janissary in 1656-1657 and was promoted to the position of janissary clerk after having participated in Kamenice Campaign in 1672 and Uman Campaign in 1674. He was appointed to Crete in 1682 and served in various provinces of the island for 12 years. Between the years of 1694 and 1697, he served in Lesbos and between the years of 1697 and 1704 in Euboea. He was promoted to the office of Janissary Clerk in Istanbul in 1704. He participated in Pruth Campaign in 1711 despite of his grand old age and wrote about his campaign memories constituting this book.

The war against the Ottomans, on Gallipoli, in Palestine and in Mesopotamia was a major enterprise for the Allies with important long-term geo-political consequences. The absence of a Turkish perspective, written in English, represents a huge gap in the historiography of the First World War. The policy transformations under its leader Recep Tayyip Erdogan do not align with existing explanations based on security, economics, institutions, or identity. In *Identity Politics Inside Out*, Lisel Hintz teases out the complex link between identity politics and foreign

She further demonstrates how the Ottoman Islamist AKP used the European Union accession process to weaken Republican Nationalist obstacles in Turkey, thereby opening up space for Islam in the domestic sphere and a foreign policy targeted at achieving leadership in the Middle East. By showing how the "inside out" spillover of national identity debates can reshape foreign policy, *Identity Politics Inside Out* fills a major gap in existing scholarship by closing the identity-foreign policy circle.

The Hemshin are without doubt one of the most enigmatic peoples of Turkey and the Caucasus. Çanakkale Savaşı üzerinde kalem oynatanların çoğunda bir yanılı olarak; savaşa ve savaşa katılan kişilere bakış açısında şahsi dünya görüşünün ve ideolojisinin belirleyici olduğu görülmektedir. Halbuki doksan küsür yıl önce yaşanan bir savaşı, o günün şartlarına göre değerlendirip, objektif biçimde anlayıp yorumlamak gerekir. İşte bu anlayışı esas alarak bilgi ve belgeye dayalı bir şekilde, yerli ve yabancı kaynaklardan faydalanarak elinizdeki kitap hazırlandı. Çanakkale Savaşı üzerine yazılmış onlarca kitaba rağmen yeniden bir savaş kitabı yazmak yerine, bu kitapta belirlenen sorulara cevaplar verilerek savaş anlatılmaya çalışıldı. Soruları seçerken merak edildiği bilinen ve/veya merak edilmesi muhtemel konular soru haline getirilerek cevaplandı. Cevaplar, mümkün olduğunca teknik tabirlere boğulmadan, genel okuyucuya hitap edecek tarzda, çok uzatmadan ancak çeşitli kaynaklardaki bilgiyi içerecek şekilde "rafine" bir halde verilmeye çalışıldı. "Sorularla Çanakkale Savaşı"nda I. Dünya Savaşı'nın başlangıcından Çanakkale'nin tahliyesine kadar geçen süre içindeki siyasi ve askeri olaylar, deniz ve kara muharebeler, savaş öncesinde ve esnasında öne çıkan isimler ele alındı.

John Dewey'de deneyim ve sanat Rowman & Littlefield

Unique among World War I campaigns, the fighting at Gallipoli

brought together a modern amphibious assault and multi-national combined operations. It took place on a landscape littered with classical and romantic sites – just across the Dardanelles from the ruins of Homer's Troy. The campaign became, perhaps, the greatest 'what if' of the war. The concept behind it was grand strategy of the highest order, had it been successful it might have led to conditions ending the war two years early on Allied terms. This could have avoided the bloodletting of 1916–18, saved Tsarist Russia from revolution and side stepped the disastrous Treaty of Versailles – in effect, altering the course of the entire 20th century. This study is the first to focus on operational and campaign-level decisions and actions, which drove the conduct of the campaign. It departs from emotive first-hand accounts and offers a broader perspective of the large scale military planning and maneuvering involved in this monstrous struggle on the shores of European Turkey.

Çalışma, Dewey'in estetik ile ilgili düşüncelerini ele almakta ve onun bir estetik teorisyen, sanatın ontolojisiyle ilgili felsefi düşünce üreten bir filozof olarak değerlendirilmesi gerektiğini göstermeyi amaçlamaktadır.

Identity Politics Inside Out Yeni İnsan Yayınevi

Modern scholarship has not given Edirne the attention it deserves regarding its significance as one of the capitals of the Ottoman Empire. This edited volume offers a reinterpretation of Edirne's history from Early Ottoman times to recent periods of the Turkish Republic. Presently, disconnections and discontinuities introduced by the transition from empire to nation state still characterize the image of the city and the historiography about it. In contrast, this volume examines how the city engages in the forming, deflecting and creative appropriation of its heritage, a process that has turned Edirne into a UNESCO heritage hotspot. A closer historical analysis demonstrates the dissonances and contradictions that

these different interpretations and uses of heritage produce. From the beginning, Edirne was shaped by its connectivity and relationality to other places, above all to Istanbul. This perspective is employed at many different levels, e.g., with regard to its population, institutions, architecture, infrastructures and popular culture, but also regarding the imaginations Edirne triggered. In sum, this multi-disciplinary volume boosts urban history beyond Istanbul and offers new insight into Ottoman and Turkish connectivities from the vantage point of certain key moments of Edirne's history.

TÜRKİYE'NİN SOSYAL TARİHİ UMUT VE TRAJEDİ Routledge
The purpose of the book is twofold: first, to give an accurate and reasonably complete narrative account of the Armenian events of 1909 and their aftermath in the province of Adana and the developments leading up to and following them; and equally importantly, to provide an interpretive framework that makes some sense out of this episode in Ottoman history. The book opens with an exposition of the geographical and economic importance of the province of Adana and its vicinity in the Ottoman Empire. This is followed by a broad demographical overview of the region. The position of the Armenians in Adana at the turn of the twentieth century, their linguistical and educational characteristics, their role in the economic and social life, and their schooling effort in the province are all examined. Further, the major causes of the outbreak in the area in 1908-1909, the dimensions of the disorders in April 1909, and the responsibility for the outrages are explored along with the reestablishing of order in the district in May-August 1909. A description and an analysis of Cemal Paşa's work of humanitarian relief and reconstruction when he was provincial governor in Adana and a survey of post-1911 Adana and Cemal Paşa's governorship at Baghdad are also included in this study.

Mehmet Şenol'un uzun yıllar süren araştırmalar sonucunda hazırladığı Gayriresmi Futbol Tarihi, "küçük adam"ların tutkuyla yazdığı kişisel futbol tarihleriyle Türkiye'nin siyasal ve toplumsal tarihinin nasıl keşiştiğini gözler önüne seriyor.

Elbette ki toplumsal arenada gülmenin farklı farklı anlamları bulunmaktadır; kimi zaman mutluluk, kimi zaman kibir, kimi zaman alay, kimi zaman şefkat, kimi zaman ise küçümseme ve daha birçok anlamı vardır. Gülme denince çoğunlukla akla ilk gelen mizahdır. O kadar ki mizah ve gülme bütünleşmiş durumdadır. Mizahın kişiler arasında vuku bulmasının yanı sıra en çok etkin olduğu yer kitle iletişim araçlarıdır. Basılı gazete ve dergilerle başlayan, radyo ve televizyon ile devam eden mizah, günümüzde dijital medya (sosyal medya) ile zirveye ulaşarak kendine apayrı bir mecra oluşturmuştur. Bu son aşama mizahı herkes için ve herkes tarafından yapılabilir bir konuma sokmuştur. Basılı eserlerden başlayıp sanal ortama doğru bir gidişat izleyen mizahın serüveni "Medyatik Mizahın Panoraması" isimli bu kitapta derinlemesine irdelenmiştir. Medyatik Mizahın Panoraması kitabında, mizahın gazete, dergi, televizyon, sinema ve yeni medya gibi kitle iletişim araçlarındaki var oluş şekli hem teorik hem de uygulamalı örneklerle incelenmiştir. Bu yönüyle Medyatik Mizahın Panoraması kitabı, mizaha ilgi duyan meraklı araştırmacılar için birincil kaynak olma niteliği taşımaktadır.

Both characterizations can be correct, depending on the context. When *Democracy Breaks* aims to deepen our understanding of what separates democratic resilience from democratic fragility by focusing on the latter. The volume's collaborators--experts in the history and politics of the societies covered in their chapters--explore eleven episodes of democratic breakdown, from ancient Athens to Weimar Germany to present-day Russia, Turkey, and Venezuela. Strikingly, in every case, various forms of democratic erosion long preceded the final democratic breakdown. Although no single causal factor emerges as decisive, linking together all of the episodes, some important commonalities--including extreme political polarization, explicitly anti-democratic political actors, and significant political violence--stand out across the cases. Moreover, the notion of democratic culture, while admittedly difficult to define and even more difficult to measure, may play a role in all of them. Throughout the volume, the contributors show again and again that the written rules of democracy are insufficient to protect against tyranny. While each case of democratic decay is unique, the patterns that emerge shed much light on the continuing struggle to sustain modern democracies and to assess and respond to the threats they face.
