Despite its modest size, Portugal has played a major part in the

development of Europe and the modern world. In *Portugal in European and World History* Malyn Newitt offers a fresh appraisal of Portuguese history and its role in the world—from early Moorish times to the English Alliance of 1650–1900 and through the country’s liberal revolution in 1974. Newitt specifically examines episodes where Portugal was a key player or innovator in history. Chapters focus on such topics as Moorish Portugal, describing the cultural impact of contact

with the Moors—one of the oldest points of contact between Western Europe and Islam; the opening up of trade with western Africa; and the explorations of Vasco de Gama and the evolution of Portugal as the first commercial empire of modern times. Newitt also examines Portugal’s role in the Counter-reformation, in Spain’s wars in Europe, and in the Anglo-Portuguese alliance. Finally, Newitt analyzes the fall of fascism and the Portuguese decolonization

within the context of larger global empires and movements. This new account of a country with a rich history shows how Portugal has moved from being the last colonial power to one of the most enthusiastic proponents of the modern European ideal.

A family of Portuguese farmers struggle to survive as world events pass them by in “a novel that resounds with

Winner of the City of Lisbon Prize Celebrated author Jose Saramago has delighted readers around the world with his imaginative tales and evocative depictions of life in his native Portugal. His novel *Raised from the Ground* follows the changing fortunes of the Mau Tempo family—poor landless peasants not unlike Saramago’s own grandparents. Set in Alentejo, a southern province of Portugal

known for its vast agricultural estates, the novel charts the lives of the Mau Tempos as national and international events rumble on in the background—the coming of the republic in Portugal, the two world wars, and an attempt on the dictator Salazar’s life. Yet nothing really impinges on the grim reality of the farm laborers’ lives until the first communist stirrings. *Raised from the Ground* is Saramago’s most deeply personal novel, the book in which he found the signature style and voice

that would win him the Nobel Prize in Literature.

Après une introduction générale qui indique les grands courants de la littérature ibéro-américaine, on aborde l'étude des littératures de tous les pays d'Europe et d'Amérique de langues espagnole et portugaise.

Pour chaque pays, on trouve une introduction, des textes choisis et une bibliographie. Cet ouvrage (1) est le résultat d'un travail d'équipe auquel ont participé des universitaires, des critiques et des écrivains français et ibéro-américains. Ce manuel répond à un besoin croissant de connaître et d'étudier la littérature ibéro-américaine de notre temps. Il est destiné aux élèves de classes terminales des lycées et aux étudiants d'université. Il comporte

une Introduction Générale qui indique les grands courants de la littérature ibéro-américaine, et une présentation des littératures de tous les pays d'Europe et d'Amérique de langues espagnole et portugaise. Il fait une place à des littératures habituellement ignorées, comme celles d'Amérique Centrale ou des Caraïbes. Pour chaque pays, quelques pages d'introduction ont pour tâche d'expliquer les liens entre l'histoire contemporaine et la

création littéraire. A la suite de ces pages d'introduction, les étudiants et les professeurs trouveront pour chaque pays une bibliographie sommaire et un certain nombre de textes choisis. Chaque texte est précédé d'un bref commentaire permettant de le situer dans l'œuvre de l'auteur. Le critère qui a présidé au choix est avant tout le caractère actuel de l'oeuvre : roman, poésie, conte, et éventuellement, selon le pays, théâtre et essai. On n'a pas oublié

les jeunes écrivains de la nouvelle génération qui font une entrée en force dans les lettres ibéro-américaines. En somme, ce manuel constitue une tentative d'appréhension de l'ensemble ibéro-américain à travers son expression littéraire. L'étude de ces littératures devrait nous amener à mieux cerner le problème suivant : qu'est-ce que le monde ibéro-américain ? (1) Ecrit en espagnol ou en portugais selon le pays étudié.
